MARKET SUMMARY: Currently, there are 8 pending properties on the plateau and 62 actives. The Dow is at an all-time high and the S&P 500 hasn't suffered a downturn of 5% or more since June 26, 2016, the economy is looking up. How long will it last? No one knows for sure. I have read anywhere from the middle of 2018 until the end of 2019 to see a correction take place. If you are thinking of selling, I am recommending doing so within the next 6-8 months.

MONTHLY TIP: With Summer in full swing, I have been cooking outdoors on the grill. There is an element of risk when grilling since you are dealing with a large flame and no one wants to get burned or start a fire. I) Check to see if your grill has been recalled. You can go to SaferProducts.gov. 2) Be sure your grill is placed on even ground and well balanced and keep away from the home, deck, railings, eaves and tree branches. Never use a grill indoors or in a breezeway, carport, porch, garage or near or under a surface that will burn. 3) Inspect the hoses on a gas grill for cracking, brittleness, holes and leaks. Make sure there are no sharp bends in the hose or tubing and that all connections are secure. 4) Check for gas leaks. Brush a soapy solution at the connection. If bubbles appear there is a leak. Try tightening the tank. If that does not stop the leak, close the gas valve and have the grill repaired. Happy grilling!
